

Why We Need Just Health Care Model Union Resolution

WHEREAS, health care in the United States is a national disgrace and in the throes of an escalating crisis of cost, accessibility and quality; and

WHEREAS, health insurance premiums have skyrocketed over 10% per year these past three years with no end in sight and more than 80% of all employers increased employee co-payments and premium contributions; and

WHEREAS, these increases have helped sustain a climate of concessionary bargaining, pushing down our wages, causing bitter strikes and lockouts and shifting more and more of the costs onto the backs of workers; and

WHEREAS, millions of retired Americans stand to lose all or part of their hard won "lifetime" health coverage as 80% of all large companies have plans to require retirees to pay more for their coverage and 20% of Fortune 500 companies plan to eliminate it altogether; and

WHEREAS, the employment based system of health coverage puts our benefits at risk every time we face a lay off, change our job or go on strike; and

WHEREAS, all other industrialized countries provide comprehensive coverage to all citizens regardless of employment status, putting U.S. manufacturing employers and workers at a global competitive disadvantage; and

WHEREAS, more and more of our friends, neighbors and family members have no health coverage at all as the number of uninsured Americans climbs past 44 million; and

WHEREAS, Americans pay more for health care than any other country in the world and yet we rank 28th in infant mortality, 14th in life expectancy and our freedom of choice and access to services is controlled by the profit driven dictates of HMOs and "managed care;" and

WHEREAS, the Labor Party has worked with hundreds of national, regional and local unions, community groups and public interest organizations to develop the Just Health Care campaign as a comprehensive solution to this crisis; and

WHEREAS, Just Health Care would provide cradle to grave coverage for all Americans through a public insurance fund and a private health care system with free choice of doctors, hospitals and clinics; and

WHEREAS, by taking the profit out of health care and incorporating a fair financing system, Just Health Care will ensure a just transition for all displaced health industry workers while 95% of all taxpayers save money; and

WHEREAS, our dedication, spirit and activism needs to be joined with all others who are engaged in education, action and mobilization on this issue; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the membership of	hereby endorses the Just Health Care

national health insurance where individuals select their own providers and where the	nere are no premium costs, no co-pays,
